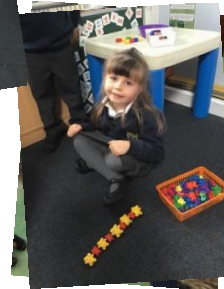
## Unicorn Class Newsletter

We will begin to retell stories using prompts and actions and in literacy we will write some simple words and phrases using our phonics knowledge. We will work on our computer and programming skills to get the little pigs Beebots back to their homes before the big bad wolf catches us!
