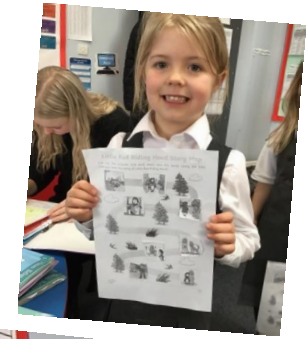

Updates

Unicorn class have been busy over the past couple of weeks continuing our learning on our Traditional Tales topic. We have sequenced stories and written wanted posters for the big, bad wolf in literacy and have created a Goldilocks dance in PE. This week we will be creating and testing the strength of some houses for The Three Little Pigs. In maths we have looked at the composition of number 5 and found different ways to make 5 with items from around the classroom. The children have now learnt all of the sounds in set 1 phonics; we will be reviewing them up until Christmas before moving onto set 2 in January. Any practice of these sounds at home would be fantastic for children to consolidate their learning.

In the next couple of weeks the children will create some writing and artwork based on the Christmas story.

- Remember to bring reading books to school each day, we will try to read with the children as much as we possibly can.
- Can all parents check that their children's jumpers and cardigans are clearly labelled; some names seem to have washed off.
