1. Study the picture:

- How do you think the artist built up the colours on the picture?
- Is there one layer or more than one?
- Which layers are at the top and which are at the bottom?
- Which part do you think was added first or last?

2. Plan your own version:

- In pencil, gently draw the basic shape outlines where the important parts of your image will go.
- Use faint lines to show which direction your layers will go (notice how many come out from the sun).
- Plan the position and size of your people (notice how they are small in relation to the page).

3. Make your own version:

- If you have coloured paper, make your own collage version.
- If not, be creative! You could use pencils, crayons, paint or any other media you have!
