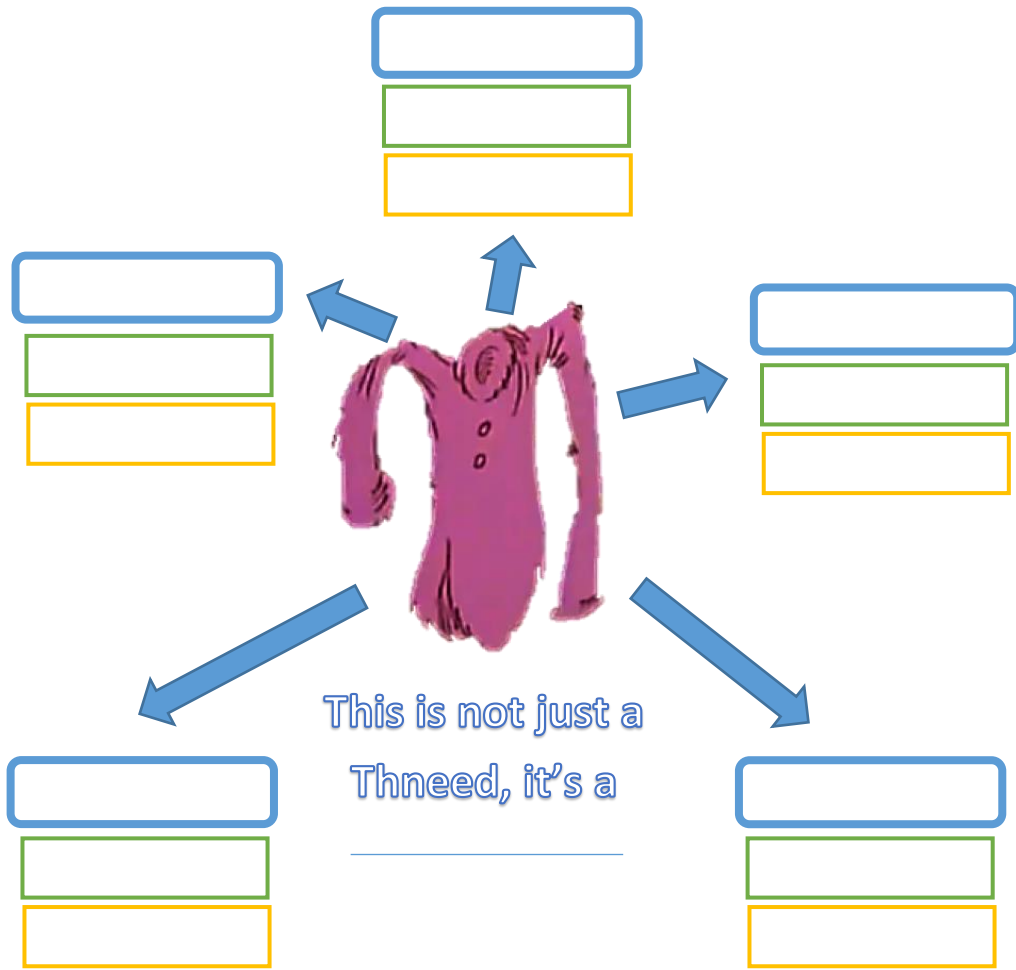


"We all need a Thneed!"



Pick an 'er' word and practise writing a sentence with it.

Pick an 'est' word and practise writing a sentence with it.

Often you can just add 'er' or 'est'. But remember, if there's already an 'e', you don't need to add another!

If the root word ends in a 'y', swap the 'y' for an 'i' before you add 'er' and 'est'.

bright	new
clean	soft

cute	small

Be careful! Some words don't sound right with 'er' and 'est'... For these words, we'd put the word 'most' in front instead, e.g. the most beautiful Thneed.
