Which are the warm colours?

Reds, oranges, yellows, pinks.

What do these colours make you think of?

Ideas: sunshine, fire, flames, lamps, candles, glowing lights.

Which are the cold colours?

Blues, greys, silvers, greens.

What do these colours make you think of?

Ideas: water, the sea, rain, ice, snow.

Which palm trees are in the foreground?

Which are the in background?

How has the artist shown that some are near and some are far?

Get Thinking...



Which palm trees are in the foreground?

These ones because they are in front of everything else.

Which are the in background?

These ones because they are right on the skyline.

How has the artist shown that some are near and some are far?

The closer ones are much larger and the far away ones are smaller. The ones at the front overlap everything else in the image.



Get Thinking...

Where are the lightest and darkest colours in the sunset?

How has the artist made it look like the sun is glowing?

Do you like the reflection?

Do you like the silhouette (the objects being black shadows)?



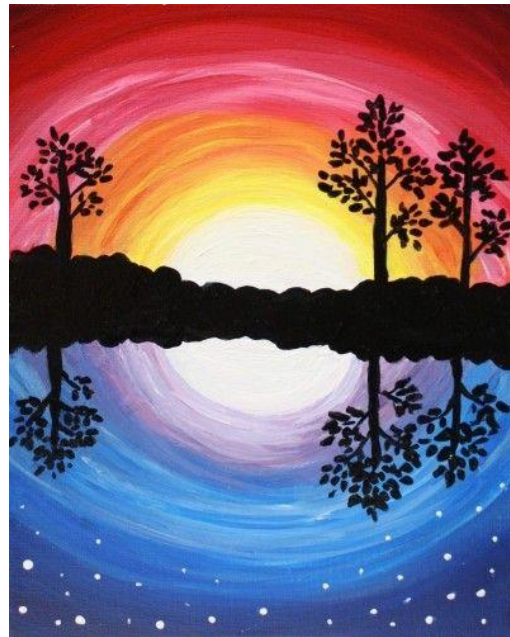
Get Thinking...

Where are the lightest and darkest colours in the sunset?

The lightest colours are in the middle then it gets darker as you move out.

How has the artist made it look like the sun is glowing?

The sun has been left white so it looks bright. Little streaks of lighter colours are used in the dark parts to show the glow.



Your Turn!

Have a go at creating your own sunset scene following these steps:

1. Draw your skyline about halfway down the page.
2. Draw the outline some land or objects in the foreground (e.g. islands, cliffs, palm trees). Remember these should be large as they are close to use.
3. Draw the outline of some land or objects along the skyline. Remember these need to be smaller as they are further away!
4. Draw where your sun will go along the skyline.
5. Add reflections in the sea if you would like them.
6. Use warm colours to shade your sunset and cold colours to shade the reflection in the sea.
7. Colour your other objects. You could do them as black silhouettes or shade them in darker colours.
