Focus: Christianity (The Creation and Fall, People of God and Jesus as an inspiration)

- I can recognise where The Creation story appears in the timeline of the Bible.
- I can make links between Genesis 1 and what Christians believe about the Creation.
- I ask questions to find out the importance of the Creation story.
- I know who Noah was and can explain the idea of the covenant.
- I understand the promises made at a wedding ceremony and also in everyday life and how these link to the story of Noah.
- I can give examples of how Christians are inspired by Jesus.
- I can identify the most important parts of the Easter story.

Focus: The importance of prayer (Islam and Christianity)

- I can describe how some people pray.
- I recognise how prayer helps some religious believers.
- I can compare prayer from different religions and recognise similarities and differences.
- I can consider the significance of prayer in the lives of people today.

Focus: Religious Festivals (Islam and Judaism)

- I recognise some differences between some religious ceremonies and other types of celebration.
- I ask questions to find out what matters most to believers at festivals.
- I can suggest why religious festivals are valuable to many people.

Focus: Right and Wrong (Islam, Christianity and Judaism)

- I can recall some of the rules for living in religious traditions.
- I can carry out research to find out about religious teachings for good living.
- I can make connections between stories of temptation.
- I can express my own ideas about right and wrong.
